#### June 2024 Time with Tom

June is a month when we send our children out after graduation into a world full of possibilities but also a world full of wolves. High School graduates may look for summer employment or may fill their days with activities, playing and enjoying their last days of living with parents soaking in the blessings of youth in the care of a parent. College graduates will no doubt begin a career after years of study and preparation. They have been working hard to develop skills and knowledge for just that purpose. The hopes and dreams of both the student and the parent are high at this point and we all want what is best for our children, and we want them to be happy and successful. This is a great time of the year for all people. Jesus at the end of his ministry on earth sent his disciples out into the world to attend to the people God had called them too. It is a time of saying goodbye and a time of testing the metal of our training. Like Jesus, the parents of our graduates have done all they can to this point but will not abandon them. It is a time of freeing them to begin working this out on their own. Jesus says in Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Can we send our children like lambs into a world full of wolves without an advocate?
